In 1993, he became "Associate" at The Royal Academy of Music in recognition of his career as a concert artist. In 2012, Mr. Andrews was named "Membre d'Honneur" of the "Association Grand Orgue Trinite Messiaen".

Mr. Andrews has given concerts all over the world with multiple tours in Asia, Europe and Russia. He has played in all major concert halls in Asia, such as Suntory Hall, Tokyo, Esplanade Theaters-on-the-Bay, Singapore, Beijing National Center for Performing Arts, Shanghai Oriental Arts Center, Sydney Town Hall, Australia, Auckland Town Hall, New Zealand etc. Other important venues include The Royal Festival Hall, London, King's College, Cambridge, The Cathedral of Notre-Dame, Paris (3 concerts), The Moscow Conservatoire, The St. Petersburg Philharmonic Hall and Mariinsky Theater Concert Hall, St. Petersburg, Russia, The National Convention of the American Guild of Organists, as well as innumerable Cathedrals in Europe, USA, Siberia, South Africa and South America. Mr. Andrews is very active as a teacher and lecturer and was a faculty member of Éast Carolina University and Indiana University.
